Entry Fee: \$30 (Do not mail entry forms)
(\$10 for each additional division entered*)

Sanction: This tournament is sanctioned by United States Judo as an **Open Tournament**.

Eligibility: Any Judo player, currently an active member of USAJudo (USJI), USJA, USJF, ATJA or AJJF (please acquire membership prior to attending the tournament).

Scoring System: Divisions with 6 or fewer will compete in the Pool System. Those with 7 or more will compete in Pool Knockout/Repechage System.

Seniors Advanced-4 minute matches; Juniors, Novice & Masters-3 minute matches.

Divisions:

Kata: Nage no Kata, & Katame-no-Kata will be contested. Male, female or coed teams may enter either or both divisions

Masters Men (30+ years old, 10 year brackets: 30-39, 40-49, etc. Light, Middle & Heavy.)

Masters Women (30 + years old, Light, Middle & Heavy.)

Seniors Men Brown & Black Belt (National weights if possible, dependent on turnout),

Senior Women Brown & Black Belt Weights dependent upon turnout.

Seniors Men Novice (White-Green Belts) Weight dependent upon turnout. **No Armbars**

Senior Women Novice (White-Green Belts) Weights dependent upon turnout. **No Armbars.**

Junior Boys, Girls (5-16 years old) Divisions: Age/Weight divisions dependent upon turnout.

5-12 year old division: **No chokes or armbars**, 13-16 years old division: **No armbars.**

Junior Novice Boys, Girls: (5-16 years old who have competed in less than three tournaments, or who have not placed in any previous event)-Age/Weight divisions to be determined by turnout.

5-12 year old division: **No chokes or armbars**, 13-16 years old division: **No armbars.**

*** (13-16 Year olds may also compete in the Senior Divisions for the additional fee; Masters may also compete in the Senior Divisions for the additional fee. In Junior Divisions no junior will compete against anyone more than 15% heavier, unless requesting to be moved up from an uncontested division by the coach, parent or the competitor).**

(Blue & Purple Belt Teens competing in the Senior Division will compete in the Brown & Black Belt Division; White-Green Belt Teens competing in the Senior Division will compete in the Senior Novice Division). The Tournament Director reserves the right to make modifications to the weight & age divisions to make competition in divisions where the competitor would otherwise be uncontested.

Set Up & Rules: 1 mat will be used; **Current IJF Rules & Sporting code** will be in effect with standard modifications concerning Shime-waza & Kansetsu-waza for juniors. U.S. National rules will be in effect for situations not covered by the IJF rules (i.e.: Vacating uncontested divisions, etc.) **Mouthpieces will be allowed. Current IJF Uniform Code will be enforced.**

Awards: Each 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner will receive a medal.

Team Trophies: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place Team Trophies will be awarded at the end of the tournament based on the following point system:

Divisions: 1st =3 pts.; Uncontested 1st =1.5 pts.; 2nd =2 pts.; 3rd =1 pt.

From Dallas: Take US 75N to Atoka, OK (the road changes its designation to US 69N), take US 69N to the Indian Nation's Turnpike, take I.N.T. N to Henryetta, (it becomes US 75N), take US 75N toward Tulsa, exit at I-44E, take I-44E to U.S. 169S to Memorial Blvd., exit & turn right (South), take Memorial to 44st St., S. turn left & then left into the parking lot.

If coming from Oklahoma City or Lawton: Take I-44E to Tulsa & to Memorial Blvd., exit & turn left (South), take Memorial to 44st St., S. turn left & then left into the parking lot.

From Arkansas: Take I-40W to US 69N, take US 69N to Memorial Blvd., exit & turn left (South), take Memorial to 44st St., S. turn left & then left into the parking lot.

From Missouri: Take I-44W to Tulsa, exit at US 169S, take US 169S to 51st St. S., exit & turn right, take 51st St., S. to Memorial Blvd., turn right on Memorial Blvd. S to 44th St. S., turn right & then left into the parking lot.
