Sanction: Sooner State Games Of Oklahoma

Eligibility: All Judo players

Scoring System: Divisions with 6 or fewer will compete in the Pool System. Those with 7 or more will compete in Pool Knockout / Repechage System.

Seniors: 4-minute matches. **Juniors & Masters:** 3-minute matches.

Divisions:

- Kata: Nage or Katame, may be contested. Teams may consist of two males, two females or a mixed team.
- Masters Men (30+ years old, 10-year brackets: 30-39, 40-49, etc. Light, Middle & Heavy)
- Masters Women (30 + years old, 10-year brackets, Light, Middle & Heavy) [Masters may also compete in the Senior Divisions for the additional fee.]
- Senior Men (National weights will be used, depending on turnout.)
- Senior Women (National weights if possible, depending upon turnout.)
- Junior Girls and Boys (Weight divisions to be dependent upon turnout):

Bantams	A: 5- 6 years old	B: 7-8 years old
Intermediates	A: 9-10 years old	B: 11-12 years old
Teens	A: 13-14 years old	B: 15-16 years old

[No junior will compete against anyone in the Junior Division who is more than 15% heavier, unless requesting to be moved up from an uncontested division by the coach, parent or competitor; Teens competing in the Senior Division for an additional fee, will compete under Senior rules.]

The Tournament Director reserves the right to make modifications to the weight & age divisions to make competition where the competitor would otherwise be uncontested.

Set Up & Rules: 1 mat will be used; **Current IJF Rules & Sporting code** will be in effect with standard modifications concerning Shime-waza & Kansetsu-waza for juniors. U.S. National rules will be in effect for situations not covered by the IJF rules (i.e.: Vacating uncontested divisions, etc.) Mouthpieces will be allowed. 2016 Uniform Code for Seniors will be enforced.

Awards: Each 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners will receive a medal.

Bantam, Intermediate Divisions:	10 minutes after completion of Master's & Teen's divisions.
Senior Divisions	10 minutes after completion of Bantam & Intermediate divisions.

WAIVER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR THE STATE GAMES OF OKLAHOMA

Release, Waiver, Discharge, and Covenant not to sue The State Games of Oklahoma, its affiliated clubs and Board of Trustees, The City of Oklahoma City, The Oklahoma Municipal Improvement Authority, The National Congress of State Games, The National Congress of State Games Board of Directors, Coaches, and other employees of the organization, or other participants, hereinafter referred to as "Release" from any and all liability to the undersigned his or hers heirs, and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death, or damage to property caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasee or otherwise. 5. In the event that I sustain injury or illness while participating in The State Games of Oklahoma I hereby authorize any emergency first aid, medication, medical treatment or surgery deemed necessary by any medical personnel. I also give permission for attending medical personnel to execute on my behalf my permission forms or other necessary medical documents and to act on my behalf if I am not immediately available to do so.
